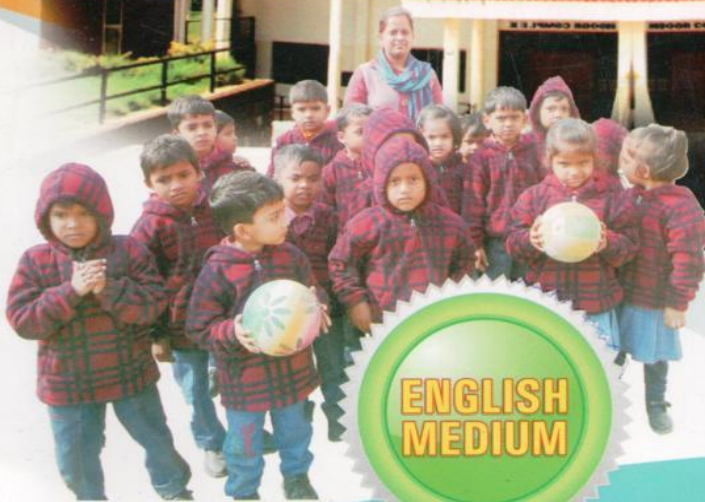

GENERAL RULES

(Registration & Admission)

1. Admission is open to all irrespective of class, creed and community
2. Application for admission of pupil should be sent to the Principal on forms supplied by the school with the Prospectus on payment of Rs. 250/-
3. The Entrance Test: General questions are designed to test the ability of the child in relevance to the standard of the class to which admission is sought, subject to permissible age, hence no books or particular courses are prescribed. The child will be tested in English, Hindi, Maths and Science.
4. No Pupil from another school will be admitted in class X.
5. The Principal reserves the authority to grant, to refuse registration/ admission for any class.
6. Fees once deposited will not be refundable in any circumstances.
7. Parents are requested to pay twelve month fee and conveyance also.

WITHDRAWAL RULES

At least one month's notice in writing is to be given to the school before withdrawing the child. The school reserves the right to withhold the transfer certificate and Report Card in case of violation of the withdrawal rules. Those who leave the school in middle of the session will have to pay the fee for the whole term.

RULES REGARDING DISCIPLINE

1. Strict regularity and Punctuality, obedience in words and deeds, cleanliness of dress and proper care of books and school property are expected from every pupil.
2. The Principal may impose fines against loss or damages to school property.
3. No expensive articles, money or jewellery should be brought to school. Students themselves would be responsible for their loss.
4. Pupils are responsible to the school authorities not only for their conduct in the school but also for their general behaviour outside. A disciplinary action will be taken against the defaulters.
5. Pupil suffering from any Contageous or infectious disease are not allowed in school they shall be permitted only on Medical certificates of fitness.
6. Irregular attendance, constant Negligence of work, insubordina-tion of teachers may lead to serious punishment.
7. The student should be punctual and regular.
8. Running in the Verandas, shouting in the class or school premises is strictly forbidden.
9. Every student should carry his/her dairy everyday.
10. Homework and other Assignments must be done without fail.
11. If school furniture, rickshaw van broken by any student. Principal is authorised to charge fine.

ROLE OF PARENTS

1. Parents are expected to co-operate with the school authorities in maintaining regularity and discipline.
2. Parents are expected to see the cleanliness and civic matters of their wards.
3. Parents and visitors may see the Principal between 09.00 a.m. to 10.00 a.m. in all working days.
4. Parents should be alert in case of Private conveyance. Parents should arrange to take their children home within 30 minutes after the school is over or the school will not be responsible.
5. Parents and guardians are specially requested to notify the School of any change of address or telephone number.

6. We request the parents to see their wards to do their home work regularly. In case a student is negligent or misbehaves in the class/or outside, a note to that effect will be made in his/her diary for the information of the parents.
7. Parents meetings are held on the Second Saturday of every month & it is necessary for them to attend for the solutions of problems of their children.
8. Parents not attending the meetings will be liable to pay Rs. 50/- as fine.
9. School dairy should be checked everyday by the Parents to have an update information regarding test and their child's performance in the class.
